Poems should be no more than 80 lines in length, submitted as a Word Document  
and sent as an email attachment to: [submit@poetryplus.org.uk](mailto:submit@poetryplus.org.uk)

The email should clearly contain the name of the poet as anonymous poems will not  
be considered for publication

No payment will be offered for submitted poems

No more than three poems may be submitted by one poet except by invitation

By submitting a poem for possible publication, the poet is confirming that the poem  
is their own work and that they are the holder of the copyright and that they do  
give *Poetry Plus* permission to publish the poem in a future edition of the magazine.  
The poet will **always** retain the copyright to their poem.

In all matters, the Editor's decision is final

## BOOKS

Books must be books of poetry

Books should be submitted with a covering letter giving the name and contact  
details of the author

Anonymously submitted books will not be considered for review

By submitting a book for review, the author is confirming that the book is their  
own work and that they are the holder of the copyright of that book

No payment will be made for books submitted for review

Books submitted for review may not be acknowledged

Books submitted for review will be retained by the Editor
