poem is their own work and that they are the holder of the copyright and that

magazine. The poet will **always** retain the copyright to their poem.

Books must be books of poetry

Books should be submitted with a covering letter giving the name and contact
details of the author

Anonymously submitted books will not be considered for review

By submitting a book for review, the author is confirming that the book is their

Books submitted for review may not be acknowledged

Books submitted for review will be retained by the Editor
